MEET FORMAT & TEAM ENTRY INFORMATION

Entries must be submitted on Direct Athletics between Monday, March 16, 2018 and Tuesday, April 3, 2018 by 12:00pm PST. You may edit and update your entries online any time before the entry deadline. Once entries close there will be no additional entries accepted. All submitted entries to direct athletics by the April 3th deadline would be considered FINAL. Please be sure to print a copy of your team's entries and bring it to the meet as confirmation.

The Jim Click Shootout will not adhere to the NCAA requirement for on-speculative marks. Please use your discretion when doing entry performances. The University of Arizona Track & Field Program reserves the right to make additional changes in the seeding process.

We will **NOT** allow any unattached athletes to compete in this competition as it is scoring competition and against new NCAA Rules.

RELAY EVENT ENTRY PROCEDURE

After entering your seed mark for each relay event on-line, you will have spaces to enter up to 8 athlete's names per relay. Please include all four runners (in order, spaces 1-4) and any alternates (up to 4 per event, spaces 5-8) in the 8 spaces provided under each relay. You must enter each member of the relay team and any alternate(s) for the relay so we may assign a bib number for each member. Any relay runners who may compete on a relay team must be entered into the meet and have a bib number to compete.

JIM CLICK COMBINED EVENTS

If you choose to have any athletes compete in the Jim Click Combined Events...there will not be an entry fee charge and must be entered by the entry deadline. Any multi-event athlete that competes, their places will be factored into the final team scores for the Jim Click Shootout.

To register multi event athletes...use direct athletics and proceed to the Jim Click Combined Events registration page. Please let me know if you have any questions.

DINNERS, AWARDS & TEAM GIFTS

There will be dinner served on Friday night for ALL teams. Dinner will be served at 7:00pm at Hall of Champions located on the concourse level of the McKale Arena. The coaches meeting will also take place during this dinner, inside of the arena on the Mezzanine level of the McKale Center inside of the Hall of Champions.

Just a reminder: If you are bringing more than the 50 athletes (25 per team) that were contracted, you will be responsible for those extra athletes. The amount of each additional athlete will be \$30 per athlete per meal.

Buses can park along the North curb on 3rd Avenue in front of the McKale Center.

There will be 25 gifts provided to each team (men & women are separate). Therefore if you have a men's and women's team competing, you will receive 50 gifts. If there are extra gifts and you are bringing more than the 50 athletes that were contracted, then we will do the best we can to make sure everyone gets a gift.

There will be an Awards Banquet following the competition on Saturday around 7:00pm, at the Doubletree Hotel, naming the team champion as well as many other exciting awards. Following the dinner will be a coaches & staff social at Coach Fred Harvey's House. Please consider this when planning departure times. Athletes are required to wear business casual attire. If more than the 50 athletes that we have contracted to pay for all in attendance, you will be responsible for paying for those extra athletes.

COMPETITION DAY INFORMATION

Spectators can purchase tickets ahead of time online at the website at www.arizonawildcats.com. Any outside food for spectators will be allowed into the facility. Food & drinks for the athletes should enter with the teams through the athlete entrance at the Northeast side of the stadium. Spectators are NOT allowed on the track at any time.

Athlete & Coaches Entrance

Coaches and student-athletes may only enter Roy P. Drachman Stadium on the northeast end, closest to 15th Street. All credentialed student-athletes and team personnel will be allowed access through the parking lot located between the Roy P. Drachman Stadium and Murphey Soccer Complex. **ALL** athletes, coaches, and team personnel must enter through this gate only!! (See Map)

Bib Numbers/Hip Numbers

All Athletes are to wear their bib numbers on the front of their uniforms, with the exception of the pole vaulters, who can wear it on the back of your uniform. It is VERY important that competing athletes have their bibs on at all times!! Athlete bib numbers are how athletes will be allowed in and out of the stadium...they must have them with them at all times.

Check-In Procedure

The clerks tent will be located on the Northwest side of the stadium, by the start of the final straight away (See Map). Student-athletes competing in both running events and field events at the same time must check in at the clerks tent for your running event and then proceed to check-in with the head judge of their field event. They must get their hip number for their race at the final staging tent as they are responsible for reporting to the starting line for their running event, if they are in a field event. **We have a new timing system and will be making all scratches at the initial clerks tent and scratches will be made if an athlete has not checked in 15mins prior to the start of their race. This will be strongly enforced and heats will be reseeded as needed!!**

Field Events

Field participants must check-in with the head judge of their event NO LATER THAN 30 minutes prior to the start of their event. If they are not checked-in they will be scratched from the event. They may be in the area of their event for warm-ups one hour prior to the competition and 90 minutes in the pole vault and high jump events.

Running Events

Athletes are to check-in at the clerks tent located by the start of the final straight away up to 1 hour prior to the start of their event. **Athletes must be checked in for their event 15 minutes prior to the start of their event...if they are not checked in they will be scratched!!!**

Athletes must report back to the clerks tent 15mins prior to the start of their event...At that time they will be staged and given their hip numbers. When athletes are escorted out to the start line...they will be race ready. If the weather is not as nice as we plan on it being, then we will allow the athletes to wear their sweats to the start line.

- First Call: 30 minutes before start of event
- Final Call: 20 minutes before start of event
- Report to Clerks Tent: 15 minutes before start of event
- Final Staging & Hipping: 10 minutes before start of event

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Electronic Devices

Please be advised: **"The use of personal stereo devices (e.g. Video cameras, cell phones, headphones, etc.) are prohibited in the competition areas (designated by the host institution) during the course of the competition. The meet referee will issue a warning to anyone using such a device. A second violation of the rule at the same meet would result in disqualification from that meet."** That will include anywhere within the stadium fences, except the training tent, bleachers, warm-up area and spectator.

Field Access

Coaches will be allowed on the track and infield. Please instruct athletes, trainers, managers, etc. to stay behind the fence that circles the track when not in competition or attending to an injured athlete. We want to keep the infield as clean as possible, so if an athlete is not competing they are not allowed on the infield.

Implement Weigh-ins

Implement weigh-ins are located in the building located at the North end of the track stadium (See Map) and must take place during the listed times below. All implements will be impounded at the time of weigh-in. Certified implements will then be transported to the event site. **Only certified implements may be used during official warm-ups and competition.** Meet management will provide a small selection of implements for use by any competitor. If your implement is not certified...it cannot be used for warm-ups or competition. **WEIGH-INS WILL OPEN DURING THE FOLLOWING TIMES:**

- Saturday 8:00am – 9:30am

Shot Putters

DO NOT put the shots on the grass or on the track. Putting the shot in any other area other than the shot impact area will result in disqualification!!!

Meals – Officials & All Coaches

There will be meals served for all officials, staff and visiting coaches that have athletes competing in the Jim Click Combined Events or Shootout, in the soccer team room located at the Northeast side of the stadium.

Medical Staff & Athletic Trainers

The University of Arizona athletic trainers will set up in the North end of the track stadium (See Map). Your trainers may also set up in this area. Emergency Medical Services & First Aid technicians will be onsite to provide first aid care if it becomes necessary. Parking

Parking around the fenced area of Roy P. Drachman stadium is free of charge and open to the public. Parking inside of the stadium and by the soccer field will be closed and is for meet staff only. Parking is available on a first come, first serve basis.

Preferred Lanes

When preferred lanes are needed for seeding purposes, the following will be used: 5-6-4-7-3-8-2-9-1. Heats will run slowest to fastest.

Pre-Meet Practice Sessions

The track will be open for practice on Thursday & Friday, however, we will be hosting the Jim Click Combined Events and we ask that all teams be respectful of the athletes competing in the Multi-Events. The Jim Click Combined Events will begin on Thursday, April 6th at 11:30am and is scheduled to end at 3:30pm. The second day will begin at 10:00am and is scheduled to end by 2:30pm.

The meet will be scored using Championship scoring (10-8-6-5-4-3-2-1) and the relays are scored (5-3-2-1). There will be a Men's team Champion and a Women's team Champion. If any team has athletes that are competing in the Jim Click Combined Events...they will be scored and factored into the final score of the competition. The maximum number of entrants is 34 per gender. Additional entrants may be entered as non-scoring. We will also award a male and female athlete of the meet that will be voted on by the coaching staff and given out at the banquet.

Spikes

Spikes with one-quarter (1/4") or three-eighths (3/8") will be allowed.

Warm-up/Cool-Down Area

No warm-ups are permitted on the track at any time. Murphey Soccer Complex will be used for warm-up and cool-down, located on the northeast side of the stadium. Blocks and hurdles will be provided in the warm-up area. Because the hurdle race will be the first running event, the Women's hurdlers will be allowed to do hurdle warm-up on the back stretch and the Men's hurdlers will be allowed to do hurdle warm-up on the home stretch.

Relay Cards

Relay Cards will need to be included in your packet and will only need to be filled out if you have a change in order. All cards will need to be handed in at the clerks tent no later than 30mins before the start of the race.

Team Tents

Teams will be allowed to set-up their tents in the northwest corner of the stadium or along the east side of the warm-up track (pop-up tents only near the warm-up track). To order a tent for your team, please contact Arizona Party Rentals at 520-327 6678. Team tents may also be set up at the very top of the West side bleachers on a first come first serve basis.

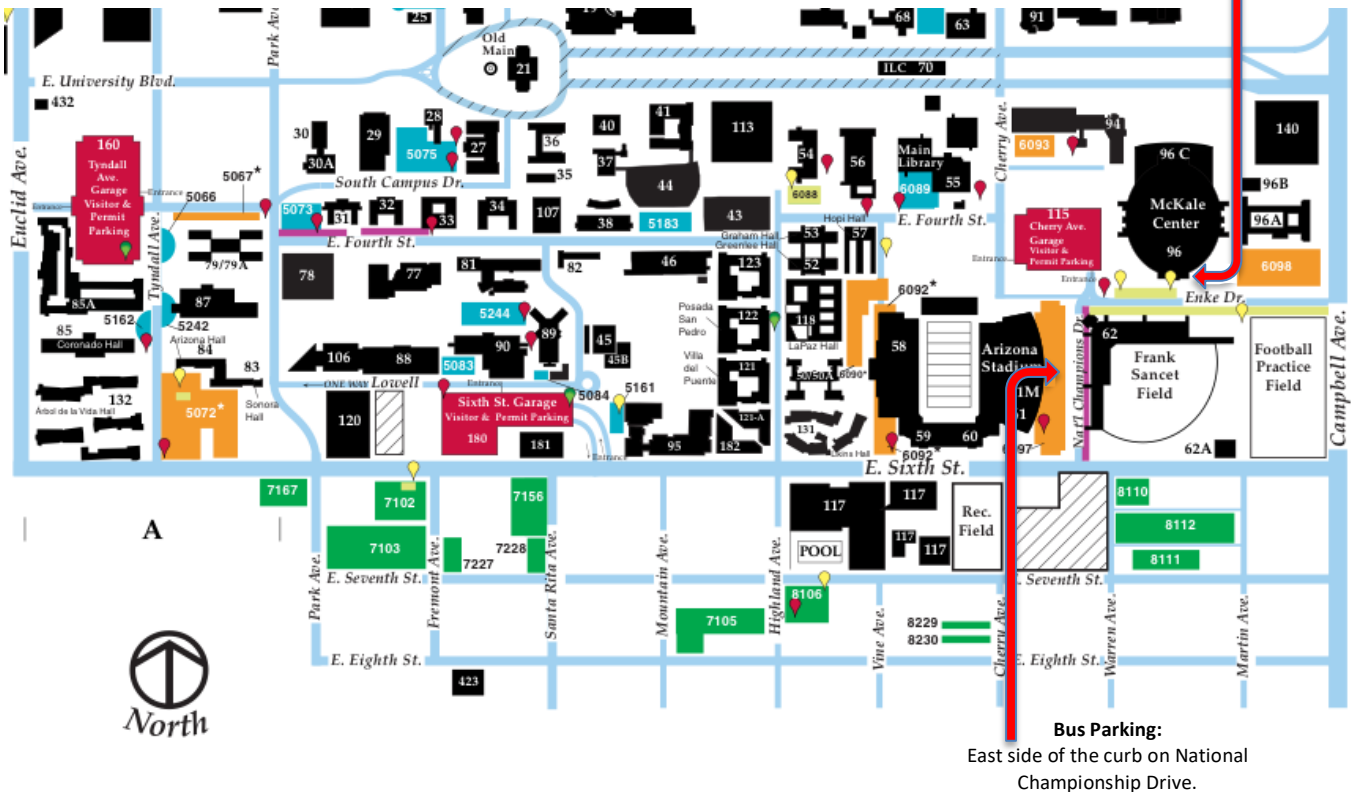

ALL TEAM DINNER LOCATION & BUS PARKING INFORMATION FRIDAY, APRIL 6, 2018

There will be dinner served on Friday night for ALL teams. Dinner will be served at 7:00pm at Hall of Champions located on the concourse level of the McKale Arena. The coaches meeting will also take place during this dinner, inside of the arena on the Mezanine level of the McKale Center inside of the Hall of Champions. Bus needs to drop off on in front of McKale Center (North-side) on Enke Dr. by the Ticket office and then teams will walk around the building to the right (East) to the Hall of Champions.

Just a reminder: If you are bringing more than the 50 athletes (25 per team) that were contracted, you will be responsible for those extra athletes. The amount of each additional athlete will be \$30 per athlete per meal.

There has been a change in where the buses will be able to park due to an event that will be going on on 3rd Ave. Buses can park along the East side of the curb on National Championship Drive...This is reserved for visiting team buses and is on a first come first serve basis. If there are not any spots then buses can park in a satellite place and here are two options for satellite locations. One location is the Safeway that is located on the corner of Broadway & Campbell or at Himmel Park located on Tucson Blvd & 1st Street.
