



Arizona State University 2020 Meet Information

QUICK INFORMATION

The Arizona State University track and field meets hosted at the Sun Angel Track Stadium are typically two-day events with a couple exceptions. Most competitions will feature the brunt of the action on the Saturday of that particular weekend with the hammer throw events always taking place the Friday before. There may be other events that will take place on Fridays and participants are encouraged to check out the meet schedule preceding the meet for a complete listing of these.

Entry Fees:

- **Baldy Castillo Invitational (3/20-21)** \$600 per team, per gender (\$1,200 for men's & women's team)
- **Sun Angel Classic (4/2-4)** \$500 per team, per gender (\$1,000 for men's & women's team)
- **ASU Invitational (4/24-25)** \$500 per team, per gender (\$1,000 for men's & women's team)
- **Individuals/Unattached entries** \$50 per athlete

For all of the meets, entries will be granted based on a team-by-team and individual-by-individual basis. Information on that is below.

REGISTRATION (TEAMS & INDIVIDUALS)

Entry Method: Teams and individuals wanting to compete in any Arizona State University track and field meet must register online at www.directathletics.com. Entries only will be accepted online via Direct Athletics. Questions regarding entering athletes on the DirectAthletics.com web site should be sent to support@directathletics.com. All meet entries will open February 16th, 2020.

Invited Teams: If a coach would like to register a collegiate team for a meet at ASU, a member of that schools coaching staff should contact Passion Gamble (passion.gamble@asu.edu or 480-340-4000) to have that school added to the list of invited teams on Direct Athletics. Only teams set as invited on the Direct Athletics site will be able to register for the meet (Clubs are not considered a team for all Arizona State Track and Field Meets).

Individual Entry: (Professional, Post-Collegiate, Club or Unattached): If you are an individual that would like to compete in any of the 2020 Arizona State Invitational meets (Baldy Castillo, ASU Invite, and/or Sun Angel Classic) you must email Passion Gamble (passion.gamble@asu.edu), to discuss possible entry and final approval for entry. Approval for entry does NOT GUARENTE you will be a participant in the meet. Approved entrants will be given a password to complete online entry. ASU meets are very competitive and space is limited. An email with entries must include a link to the PROOF OF PERFORMANCE within the last two years in order to be considered (2019 Indoor/Outdoor Track and 2020 Indoor/Outdoor Track ONLY). All individual athletes MUST PAY their entry fee **ONLINE** and all payments are FINAL. If you do not make it into the meet there will be NO refund, it is an entry fee not a participation fee. Paying entry fee is NOT a guarantee to compete. It is only an entry fee, not a competition fee. If entries are declared on Direct Athletics without payment being submitted prior to declaration ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ALLOWED ON THE LIST OF DECLARED ATHLETES.

Again...Individuals trying to register for any meet are **NOT** assured of a place in the meet. Meets held at ASU give preference to collegiate teams and their competing individuals **FIRST** and then will fill in the fields of competition with the individual/unattached individuals that have been approved for the meet. Individuals **MUST** receive an email from the Meet Director with approval to gain entry into the meet. **Entry into the meets does not guarantee you will be accepted into the meet.** The accepted lists will be posted the evening after the entries are due.



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Entry Information:

Note to all Team Coaches:

Each coach/program must have a Direct Athletics username and password for his/her school. If you do not know your username and password, you will be able to create one or retrieve your existing account by following the instructions below. You will use the same account to enter all meets run through Direct Athletics.

If you already have a Direct Athletics account and know your username/password, then proceed as follows:

1. Go to www.directathletics.com
2. In the login box, enter your username and password and click Login

If you DO NOT know your username and password, proceed as follows:

1. Go to www.directathletics.com
2. Click on the link New User Click HERE.
3. Follow onscreen instructions. You will be able to create/retrieve team account information

Note About Direct Athletics Accounts

Most coach accounts control a schools Men's AND Women's team. You control only one gender at time, so you will complete the below steps for your Men and then switch to your Women's and repeat the process (or vice versa). The team you are controlling is listed on the blue navigation bar across the top of your account.

****ATTENTION COLLEGIATE COMPETITORS****

With the creation and implementation of the TFRRS System for collegiate track and field and its use of specific athlete identification codes, we will only accept entries into the meet through the Direct Athletics registration pages and **WILL NOT** allow late entries to be submitted. The **ONLY** exception to this will be adding an athlete into an event if he/she is already registered in another event in the meet (if space is available). **NOTE:** Walk-up registration of an athlete (regardless of affiliation or classification) at a meet **WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED**, so please be sure to register all athletes prior to the listed deadlines.

ENTRY MARKS FOR ALL COLLEGIATE COMPETITORS MUST BE TFRRS MARKS FROM THE 2019 INDOOR/OUTDOOR SEASON AND THE 2020 INDOOR/OUTDOOR SEASONS ONLY. WE WILL FOLLOW NCAA RULE 4.1.13 – ENTRY MARKS WILL BE PUBLISHED WITH THE ACCEPTED ENTRY LIST. PLACEMENT OF HEATS AND FLIGHTS WILL BE AT THE SOLE DISCRETION OF THE MEET MANAGEMENT STAFF. IF YOU HAVE ANY ADDITIONAL SEEDING NOTES (EX. FRESHMAN/TRANSFER COMPETITOR, CONVERSION FROM INDOOR TO OUTDOOR TIMES/DISTANCES, ETC.) PLEASE EMAIL PASSION GAMBLE (passion.gamble@asu.edu) BEFORE THE ENTRY DEADLINE OTHERWISE THOSE INDIVIDUALS WILL STAY AS A “NO MARK” OR WILL DEFAULT TO THE MARK ENTERED.

Professional, Post-Collegiate, Club, Open and Unattached Entries: If you are entering yourself into the meet as an open or unattached individual athlete, you must create an INDIVIDUAL account on www.directathletics.com.

• PLEASE NOTE: Individuals trying to register for any meet are **NOT** assured of a place in the meet. Meets held at Arizona State give preference to collegiate teams and their competing individuals **FIRST** and then will fill in the fields of competition with the individual/unattached individuals that have been approved for the meet. Individuals **MUST** receive an email from the Meet Director with approval to gain entry into the meet. Entry into the meets does not guarantee you will be accepted into the meet. Accepted lists will be posted the evening after the entries are due.



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ASU Students: Arizona State students (with valid ASU student ID) will be able to compete for no entry fee at the Baldy Castillo Invitational, ASU Invite, and Sun Angel Track Classic home meets. ASU students wishing to enter into a meet must do so by emailing meet director Passion Gamble (passion.gamble@asu.edu) with event(s) and seed mark(s) (DO NOT ATTEMPT TO ENTER ONLINE). Entry standards will apply.

Meet Entry/Declaration Deadlines and Heat Sheets: The Direct Athletics web site and ASU track & field will not allow late entries into any meet. Meet Entries will close at 11:59PM PST on the Tuesday preceding the meet for the Baldy Castillo Invitational and the ASU Invitational.

SUN ANGEL CLASSIC MEET ENTRIES WILL CLOSE ON MARCH 25th AT 11:59PM PST. DUE TO THE ENTRIES AND SIZE OF THIS MEET, TIME IS NEEDED FOR OFFICIATING AND STAFFING.

Accepted Entries

Accepted entries will be posted on the evening following the close of entries. **For Sun Angel, entries will be posted the Monday before (3/30).** Heat sheets will be posted 24 hours prior to the start of the Saturday events for the Saturday event heat sheets. Heat sheets for Friday events will be posted 24 hours prior to the first event on Friday.

Meet Scratches

In order to make the meets run as smoothly as possible and to insure all lanes will be filled and flights properly sized for the meets, please email ALL scratches to the assistant meet director, John Ellis (John.ellis.1@asu.edu) or call 503-757-8537 no later than 12:00pm PST on the Thursday prior to the competition. For The Sun Angel, scratches are to be reported Tuesday prior to the start of the meet by 3pm PT.

MISCELLANEOUS INFORMATION

Due to the implications of NCAA Bylaws 20.9.7.1, 20.9.7.2, 20.9.7.3.2 we will make sure that our meets qualify as a counter meet for sports sponsorship. Based off of the team entries into our meets a decision will be made if the meet falls under the 2/3rds rule or not. If the team entries do not have more than 2/3rds Division 1 institutions we will score the meet accordingly to allow institutions to use the meet as a counter for sports sponsorship. If we meet the 2/3rds requirements we will not score the meet. If you have any questions or concerns about these new Bylaws please contact meet director Passion Gamble.

Entry Fees:

- Sun Angel Classic \$500 per team, per gender (\$1,000 for men's & women's team)
- ASU Invitational \$500 per team, per gender (\$1,000 for men's & women's team)
- Baldy Castillo Invitational \$600 per team, per gender (\$1,200 for men's & women's team)
- Individuals/Unattached entries \$50 per athlete (must receive password from meet director)
- ASU students with valid ASU ID may compete for free

***A team bringing men and women would be \$1,000 (\$500 for the men, \$500 for the women) for Sun Angel Classic and ASU Invitational and \$1,200 (\$600 for the men, \$600 for the women) for Baldy Castillo Invitational.

***Entry fee must be paid in full BEFORE the start of competition or that team/individual will be scratched.



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Practice Requests and Fees:

Collegiate teams that will be in town prior to Thursday of the week of the meet or that stay after the following week will be allowed to use Sun Angel Stadium for practices (practice times and facility availability prior to each meet can be arranged with Passion Gamble - passion.gamble@asu.edu or 480-340-4000) or in the ASU Track & Field Office. **Mesa Community College (roughly 15-20 minutes from ASU) is also available for use. Team Camps & Tent Rental:

Team camps will be located on the Performance Field to the east of the track facility, across Rural Road. Please refer to the map on page 10 of this packet. Teams will use the Performance Field for their team camps and warm-up area for the Baldy Castillo Invite and the Sun Angel Classic ONLY! Teams camp space will be available on the east side of Sun Angel Stadium during the ASU Invite. Payment Options:

- TEAMS ONLY may pay their entry fee(s) at packet pick-up (times & location listed below). Individuals MUST make their payments through Direct Athletics prior to the competition.
- All checks should be made to Arizona State Track and Field. Receipts of payment also will be made available.
- Individuals/unattached athletes must pay their entry fees through the Direct Athletics web site at the time of registration.
- All entry fees are non-refundable and non-transferable...entries must be paid in advance and received by the close of entries for all individual/unattached individuals... failure to pay entry fees will result in being **scratched!**

Team Packet Pickup:

Entry fees will be able to be paid and packets can be picked up from 10am-Noon and 3-5pm on Friday. There are no other times available for packet pick up. If a representative from your team is unable to be at the times listed above to make payment and receive your teams' packet, please email Passion Gamble at passion.gamble@asu.edu or call 480-340-4000 prior to that Friday to make arrangements. Packets will contain a set of heat sheets (updated following scratches), final competition schedule, opening heights & progressions and wrist bands for all coaches/competitors/staff. Packets can be picked-up at the south end of the stadium (closest to tennis center) closest to the start/finish line.

Credentials:

Wristbands will be issued to competing athletes, managers, coaches, media and medical staff for entry into each meet. All coaches, staff and athletes are asked to enter Sun Angel Stadium through the South entrance, located at the southwest corner of the stadium (closest to the tennis facility). Athletes, coaches and staff are asked to wear their wristbands at all times to gain entrance in and out of the facility. The infield area of Sun Angel Stadium will be restricted to athletes and athletic training personnel ONLY during the meet, with the following exceptions:

*In the packet for your team at packet pick-up you will receive wrist bands for those coaches that will be allowed on the field of the track during the meet to coach their athletes in a field event. Not all field event coaches will receive a special wristband.



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Heat Sheets:

Heat sheet will be posted on-line on the ASU Track & Field page of www.thesundevils.com at the dates and times listed prior. Heat sheets also will be included in each team's packet(s).

Timing, Results Posting (online and on-site):

- Result boards are located near the North end of the stands with signage directing you there.
- An updated schedule of events also will be posted on the boards
- Timing and results will be done by Finished Results.
- Live results can be viewed on your smartphones using the Finished Results Live App

Track Shoes:

Flats or track shoes with spikes **NO LONGER THAN 1/4 INCH** are acceptable at Sun Angel Stadium.

Permitted spikes include: RUNNER'S WAREHOUSE #TP14 1/4" PYRAMID SPIKE ONLY

Banned spikes include: CHRISTMAS TREE AND NEEDLE SPIKES



- Spikes will be checked prior to entry of facility and competitions (at team entry to facility and athlete check-in and at field event locations) and any athlete not in compliance with the spike policy may be subject to disqualification from the meet

- This spike policy is for all track events at the meet with exception only made in the high jump and javelin throw allowing 3/8 inch spikes.
- The appropriate spikes will be available if needed at the team entry point for \$2.00 for 12 or \$12 per bag of 100.

DAY OF COMPETITION LOGISTICS

Warm-up Areas:

Throwers and jumpers will be allowed a 15 minute warm-up period prior to the start of their flight, as well as warm-ups off the track during competition. High jumpers will be allowed 30-45 minutes of warm up time based on field size. Runners may warm-up and shake-out on the track up to 15 minutes prior to the start of the first race. After this, athletes must use the warm-up area located east of the track complex across Rural Road.

NOTE: access to the track will be limited/restricted during all hammer competitions... those teams looking to shake-out on Friday will be restricted to one area of the track, which will be strictly enforced for safety reasons.

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Event Check-In/Clerking:

- The clerk will open 60 minutes prior to the start of racing. Athletes are asked to check in for their race at first call or 45 minutes prior to the start of their event. Athletes are asked to be inside the staging area no later than second call or 15 minutes before their race to receive hip numbers, lane assignments and last-minute instructions. Once an athlete has checked in, he/she is asked to remain in the clerking area and will be escorted to the track for his/her race.

- Field event athletes will check-in for their respective events with the event official at the location of the event.

Implement Weigh-in:

Implement weigh-in will differ based on the meet schedule. Please see the below times for each meet and the weigh in times. If you or members of your team will be unable to make weigh-ins during this time frame, please contact John Ellis at john.ellis.1@asu.edu or 503-757-8537 to make arrangements. The implement weigh-in is located under the grand stands.

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ATHLETIC TRAINING:

The Athletic Training Staff at Arizona State University would like to welcome you to Sun Angel Stadium. It is our hope that your stay in Tempe, AZ will be safe and enjoyable. This letter is provided to help ease your travel experience.

At the Sun Angel Stadium, there will be a sports medicine area staffed and equipped for your medical needs. The medical area will be located at the south side of the spectator stands. This area will host ice, basic modalities, treatment tables, as well as emergency and first aid supplies. Water coolers will also be available in the medical area, warm-up, starting line, finish line, throws and jumps areas. Members of our athletic training staff will be at the track at least an hour prior to start of the meet on Friday and Saturday. A physician will be on-call during Friday competition, and on-site during Saturday competition.
