

Welcome to the IE County Championships 2023

SCRATCHES / ADDS / ALTERNATES:

- All events have been seeded and there are **no adds...** Only scratches..... No Exceptions

GATES:

Gates will open at 6:30am athletes, coaches and spectators

General Admission Adults: \$10 Students \$5

COACHES / ATHLETES ADMISSION:

Each school will receive a credentials packet. Only coaches and competing athletes **dressed in their team uniform** will be permitted to enter through the Coaches/Athletes entrance. All others will be responsible for purchasing a ticket at the spectators' entrance.

ADMISSION / ENTRY FEES:

If we have not yet received your payment for entry, you must bring your payment with you the day of the meet.

- Absolutely no admission without payment – NO EXCEPTIONS!
- If “the check is in the mail” you need to bring a personal check to cover your entry fees
 - We will hold your check for and destroy it as soon as your school check arrives
- Cash, Personal Checks, and School Checks are accepted
- Entry fees are based upon original number of accepted entries
- Your athletes will NOT be allowed to compete until we have collected your entry fees

SPIKES:

We will check spikes for ALL athletes that enter through the team gate. Have your athletes plan ahead by having their competition shoes out with the correct spikes in. The maximum allowable spikes are 3/16”.

TEAM AREA:

Teams will be able to set up canopies on the athletic field, adjacent to the outer area perimeter of the baseball stadium. Please be cognoscente of the throws area and refrain from setting up your team area where athletes will be warming up. You may set up team areas/canopies on the North bleachers. However, the South Bleachers (closest to finishline) are reserved for paid spectators.

MEET ALTERNATES:

- All alternates must check in once the first call is made
- Should an opening become available, alternates will be accepted in the order of which they are ranked as alternates
- If an alternate does not check in by second call, he/she will be scratched from the list of alternates

CLERK OF THE COURSE:

The clerk of the course is located in the southwest corner of the stadium. Athletes are responsible for checking in with the clerk by the last call for their event. If this is not done, he/she will be scratched from that event. Please have an athlete or coach listening for these calls from the clerk. Field event athletes should report to their respective event area to check in for competition. **No calls will be made for the field events.**

CALL SCHEDULE:

30 minutes prior to an event - first call

20 minutes prior to an event - second call

10 minutes prior to an event - third & final call

Athletes in BOTH a field event and running event must keep up on the time schedule and calls for their events. A field event athlete must return and check-in with the clerk and go to the staging area if they are in a track event. Failure to do so will result in a scratch. ALL athletes in running events must check-in with the clerk of the course in the staging area. Field athletes checking out from a field event to run a race must return immediately after running, to finish their field event.

WARM-UP AREA

- All warm-ups will be done on the baseball outfield (Please stay off the infield)
- Absolutely no warm-ups are allowed on the infield
 - The only exception is hurdlers may finish their warm-up on the infield after they have checked in with the clerk of the course

SCORING:

10-8-6-5-4-3-2-1 The top performances in each event, regardless of heat or flight will be used for scoring purposes in each division.

FIELD EVENTS:

- FS athletes will be given 3 attempts as finals for all throwing and horizontal jumping events
- VAR athletes will be given 4 attempts as finals for all throwing and horizontal jumping events
- High Jump will compete using "5 Alive"
- Boys F/S Shot Put will throw a 12lb Shot
