## Entry Confirmation and Fees:

Confirmation of entry (contract) can be submitted via email, fax, or mail to Chino High School. A signed contract must be returned before receiving the password to register athletes for the meet via MileSplit.

## Entry Fees:

- \$400 for a full team (boys and girls)
- \$200 for a single-gender team (boys or girls)
- \$100 for each additional "B" team

Max Fee for school with a Full "A" and "B" team of both genders is \$600.

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### Field Events

Event	Start Time	Notes
Pole Vault	9:00 AM	Boys (8-0 Start); Followed by Girls (6-0 start)
High Jump	9:00 AM	Girls (3-6 Start); Followed by Boys (4-6 start)
Long Jump	9:00 AM	Boys (South Pit); Girls (North Pit)
Triple Jump	Following LJ	Boys (South Pit); Girls (North Pit)
Discus	9:00 AM	Boys (SW Grass); Followed by Girls
Shot Put	9:00 AM	Girls (NE Track); Followed by Boys

*Implements will be weighed starting at 7:00 AM at the competition ring. A one-minute rule is enforced for attempts.*

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## Participation & Rules

- **Athlete Limits:** Each athlete may compete in up to 4 events.
  - **Relay Instructions:** All exchange zones will be marked. Please note that on the 4x200m, the 3rd leg will hand off to the 4th leg in a waterfall with the first team at that time in lane one.
  - **Field Event Scoring:** Total distance or height from the team's (top 3 finishing) best attempts will determine scores. Please note that all field events are team based and must have 3 athletes receive marks to be counted towards the overall score. If there is only 1 single athlete competing then their score will not qualify as part of a team score.
  - **Pole Vault & High Jump:** Bar will not be lowered once raised. "Five Alive" system used.
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## Awards

- **Medals:** Top 4 teams per race and field event (boys and girls).
  - **Team Trophies:** Awarded to 1st place overall teams (boys and girls).
  - **Special Award:** Best Field Athlete Award (Ray "Grandpa" Ortiz Tribute). Coaches nominate athletes for this honor.
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## Spectator & Coach Information

### Spectators

- Tickets: Purchase via GoFan.co. Do **not** redeem tickets ahead of time.
- Seating: EZ-Ups allowed at the top of stands only. Do not stand at railings. Please do not block the announcer's view of the start/finish line.
- Parking: Available in the student lot on Park Pl. additional parking on Jefferson & 10th St.

### Coaches

- **Coaches Meeting:** 8:00 AM at the South End Zone.
  - **Warm-Up Areas:** Restricted to designated zones in the baseball fields north of the track. Additional warmup area located on the south side of the grass fields, west of the student parking lot. Please avoid the discus area.
  - **Clerk of the Course:** Located at the NW track entrance; athletes will be escorted to the competition area.
  - **Scorer's Table:** Concerns must go through the meet director—coaches and athletes are not allowed at the table.
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## FAQs

- **Rain Policy:** The meet will proceed rain or shine. No refunds on entry fees.
- **Equipment:** Teams must provide their own batons, throwing implements, and pole vault poles.
- **Trash:** Teams are responsible for cleaning their areas. Trash bags will be provided in the coaches' packet.
- **Snack Bar:** Cash and card options available; additional vendors on-site.
