# At Ontario High School

Welcome to the 14<sup>th</sup> annual Ontario Relays. We feature a 9-lane all-weather track with wide turns, jump pits and throwing areas is set up so spectators can see every event from the stands. We will be running a full assortment of individual and relay races and a full schedule of field events. The first 27 teams to return a contract for the meet will be accepted. We want to continue to make this a great early season meet for everyone!!

#### **DIVISIONS:**

This is a Varsity meet and schools will be divided as evenly as possible into 2 or 3 divisions (Large-Small schools) depending on the number of entries. The lowest division will consist of JV, F/S, B teams, and small schools. Divisions will be based on team strength from the previous year.

### **AWARDS:**

Medals will be awarded:

Individual events-top 4 athletes from each individual event (per division) Relay events-top 3 teams from each relay event (per division) Team trophies will be awarded to the top scoring teams according to division and gender.

# **ENTRY DEADLINE:**

Contracts must be returned by February 10<sup>th</sup>. Entries must be submitted by Tuesday, February 18<sup>th</sup> at 11pm to <a href="www.finishedresults.com">www.finishedresults.com</a> or <a href="https://ca.milesplit.com">https://ca.milesplit.com</a>. Once entries have been submitted, final heat sheets will be sent to coaches a few days before the meet. **THERE WILL BE NO ADDING ATHLETES/RELAYS ON MEET DAY** 

#### **MEET ENTRIES:**

Each team will be allowed 5 athletes per individual event on the track, 3 in the field, and one relay per school. The 200m is Elite 200m, ONLY TOP 18 times submitted will race. Best estimated times/marks for the individual events would be appreciated and will be used to seed heats/flights. No athletes will be added on the day of the meet, coaches will be allowed to make substitutions, but names will not be changed.

# **FACILITIES:**

Meet will be held at Ontario high school, which has a 9 lane All-Weather Track. **Only "3/16" pyramid spikes allowed!!** Spikes will be sold at the meet, \$3 for 14 spikes. Locker rooms will not be available.

#### TIMING/RESULTS:

Finished Results will manage Timing. Results will be posted after each race on a 10' x 4' LED color billboard display at the finish line. Live results will be available on the app for Finished Results. Full results will be posted on the major results websites.

#### **MEET INFORMATION:**

Field events start at 8:30am and Track events start at 9:00am; Coaches meeting will start at 8:00am. Coaches and athletes will be given a wristband to be on the field. Teams are to enter from the east side of the stadium on Cypress Ave.

#### SPECTATOR INFORMATION:

General admission is \$10 and high school students with school ID its \$5, without school ID its \$10. Children 10 years and under are free. Spectators can enter from either side of the stadium. Spectators will not be able to enter from the Francis gates. Concession stands will be available. Parking is free, main parking is off Palmetto Ave. No pets allowed in the stadium. Service animals will be allowed, you will be asked to provide proof or not be allowed to enter.

#### **MEDICAL:**

An Athletic Trainer is only available in case of injury. Ice will be provided for injured athletes only. Athletic trainer will not tape athletes prior to competition.

#### MEET SCHEDULE:

This meet will be on a rolling schedule; please listen to announcements and check in to the designated area. Any athletes that do not check in 2 minutes after last call will be scratched, NO EXCEPTIONS!! Field event athletes will have 10 minutes to report back to their field event after the athlete finishes their running event and be ready to compete or forfeit their attempts.

# RUNNING EVENT CHECK-IN PROCEDURE

Athletes or their Coaches/Managers may check-in up to 1.5 HOURS PRIOR BUT NO LATER than the ending of the event before your scheduled event. All other entries WILL BE SCRATCHED from that race. When you check in, you will be given your hip number and it is up to the athlete to show up in time to the start line on time. No exceptions will be made if the athlete is late to their event.

# FIELD EVENT CHECK-IN

Field event athletes must check-in at the Field Event they are competing in. Entry and exit into and out of the stadium for field events will be via the South East corner gate of the track.

# Weighing Implements

We will start weighing all implements as soon as the stadium is opened to avoid delays. The throwing events will start on time.
