Scoring

Scoring in individual events and relays will be 10-8-6-5-4-3-2-1 (NCAA Rule 7; Section 1; Article 2)

Check-in/Calls

Event calls at 30 minutes and 15 minutes. Athletes and coaches are responsible for reporting to the Clerk at the blue building by the finish line for check in and to be escorted to their event start line or venue.

Track event athletes must check-in no later than 30 minutes prior to the start at the Clerk, located at the blue building by the finish line. There will be a shoe and spike check (1/4" pyramids only), bib number check and hip numbers handed out. Runners report to the check-in tent 10 minutes before race time and will be escorted to the starting line 5 minutes prior to the race start.

Field event athletes report to the Clerk no later than 60 minutes prior to their event. Athletes will be escorted to their event site 45 minutes prior to the event start.

Implement Certification

All throwing implements must be certified and impounded prior to competition. Implement weigh-in will take place by the C-Trains located near the finish line. **Weigh-ins will take place on Friday, April 25 between 8:00 a.m. and 10:30 a.m.** Certified implements will be brought to the throw venue by meet officials.

Meet Officials

A Championships Committee will review and resolve all issues and disputes not under the purview of the meet officials. The Championships Committee shall be composed of the Host Athletic Director (or host school administrative designee), the PacWest Track and Field sport committee, and the Commissioner (or conference office designee.) The Championships Committee may confer with Host Head Coach, Meet Head Official, and USATF governing body, and others, as necessary. The Championships Committee decision is final and may not be appealed.

Opening Heights (vertical jumps)

Opening heights and progressions for the vertical jumps will be established at the technical meeting. Recommendations for progressions will be 15cm for the men's and women's Pole Vault, and 5cm for the men's and women's High Jumps. Attention will be given to NCAA automatic and provisional qualifying standards.

Shoes & Spikes

Shoes worn by competitors must conform to the [World Athletics approved list](#), in accordance with NCAA Rule 14, Section 4, Article 5. The model name or the model number of any shoe used in competition shall be made accessible to tournament officials.

Warm-up Area

The warm up area will be on the outfield grass of Dan Martin Stadium (baseball field adjacent to the stadium). There will be no warm-ups allowed on the track. DO NOT remove any hurdles from the track. Hurdles will be available in the warm-up area. **Please stay within the marked off area of the outfield.**

Team Arrival & Parking

Handicap Parking and Team parking for vans and cars will be in the parking lot located directly north of the track (off Willow Avenue). Bus parking will be along Willow Avenue adjacent to FPU Track. Spectator parking will be in the Steinert Athletic Complex parking lot located at the corner of Hamilton and Winery Avenues.

Passes & Credentials

Each team member (players, coaches, athletic trainers, managers) will be issued a wristband. The wristband must be visible at all times, except during practice and competition, in order to access competition and coaching areas inside the track area.

Team Tents

Team camps are on the grass berm located on the east side of the track. Entrance to the track will be on the north end of the berm. Trash cans will be placed along the fence. No team tents or camps in the grandstand.

Trash cans will be placed along the fence in the team camp area. Please clean-up team camp areas of all trash at the end of each day of competition. Restrooms are available at the Steinert Athletic Complex entrance (by baseball) Port-a-potties will also be placed near the finish line behind the Clerk's Building.

Team Member Seating

The track and the field area is restricted to access for athletes in current events to maximize their visibility, and for the live streaming broadcast to have clear lines of view. Non-participating team members must remain outside the competition area at all times when they are not actively in a competition. The grandstand, and small bleachers next to the hammer/discus throw are available for viewing.

COACHES and ATHLETIC TRAINERS are limited to the walking lane outside lane 8. No on field access for coaches. All field events coaching boxes are allowed from the walking lane. Athletes may come across the track to the coach for competition instruction. Video is allowed per NCAA rules. Coaches enter and exit the track under the scoreboard in front of the track shed.

Non-Participant Seating

Non-participating student-athletes must remain outside the competition area at all times.

Medical Services

The Sports Medicine area will be located at the **finish line** in the South West corner of the track. There you will find water, treatment tables, injury ice, first aid supplies, a cold tub and emergency supplies (AED, splint bag, crutch bag).

Teams are required to bring their own medical kit with tape and any other supplies they may need.


All treatments must be under the supervision of your institution's certified athletic trainer (AT). If you are not traveling with an AT, a formal letter from your AT specifying treatment protocols must accompany the athlete. Treatments dictated by the student athlete will not be performed. All other athletes not under the care of a certified athletic trainer will be formally evaluated by a Fresno Pacific University athletic trainer before any treatments are performed.

EVENT/ PRACTICE/ WORKOUT EMERGENCY CARE PLAN

Roles and Responsibilities:

- ⇒ **Athletic Trainer (ATC):** Responsible for care of student-athlete
- ⇒ **Athletic Training Student:** Assist ATC (i.e. grab emergency equipment)
- ⇒ **Coaching Staff:** Keep team away from injured student-athlete, crowd control, or other duties as directed
- ⇒ **Game Administrator:** Call Campus Safety by using **radio** to activate EMS during an event/ practice/ workout
No response, Call Campus Safety Primary Line: (559) 453-2298 / Secondary: (559) 647-9807
- ⇒ **Campus Safety:** Activate EMS and Direct them to Venue/ Crowd Control
- ⇒ **Call Box:** If radio contact is not available, press red button on call box (Starred on Map below)

CALLING CAMPUS SAFETY:

1. **IDENTIFY YOURSELF:** "HELLO, MY NAME IS _____; I AM A [COACH/ EVENT STAFF/ ATHLETIC TRAINING STUDENT]"
2. **DESCRIBE WHERE YOU ARE:** "I AM IN NEED OF AN AMBULANCE TO TRANSPORT AN INJURED ATHLETE FROM RAMIREZ FIELD IN THE STEINERT ATHLETIC COMPLEX. THE AMBULANCE SHOULD MAKE A TURN ONTO THE DIRT ROAD FROM THE STEINERT ATHLETIC COMPLEX PARKING LOT WHERE SOMEONE WILL DIRECT YOU."
3. **EXPLAIN WHAT OCCURRED:** "THE ATHLETE HAS SUSTAINED A (TYPE OF EMERGENCY)"
4. **DISCLOSE THE CONDITION OF ATHLETE:** (i.e. "THE ATHLETE LOST CONSCIOUSNESS AND IS NOT BREATHING")
5. **CLARIFY WHAT HAS BEEN DONE TO PATIENT:** (i.e. "WE HAVE BEGUN CPR/ AED")
6. **GIVE THEM YOUR PHONE NUMBER:** "YOU CAN CALL BE BACK AT (SAY YOUR PHONE #)" DO NOT HANG UP UNTIL CAMPUS SAFETY/EMS HANGS UP FIRST.



LOCATIONS OF EMERGENCY EQUIPMENT

- **Athletic Trainer has:** (AED, SPINEBOARD, MEDICAL KIT, SPLINT BAG, CRUTCH BAG)
- **Campus Safety** (AED)


⇒ The ATC may designate an individual (assistant coach, FPU staff member, Athletic Training Student, etc.) to accompany the injured student-athlete to the hospital.

⇒ **The ATC should not leave the venue if other Student-Athletes are still competing/ practicing.**

⇒ Parents/guardians of the injured student-athlete should be contacted by the Assistant AD for Sports Medicine or Designee.

The Fresno Pacific University Department of Athletics Emergency Action Plan (EAP) will be activated when the following incidents occur: Disability/quality of life altering injury or illness including, but not limited to, unknown abnormality cardiac arrest, head injuries, heat stroke, exertional sickling, asthma, anaphylaxis, direct trauma, lightning, and exertional hyponatremia, or sudden death of a student-athlete, coach, or staff member during an FPU event or during an official travel to/from an FPU event.


