During your track season, you don't always race the same distance over and over. So why should you during cross country? The 2-mile course is a great break from the standard distance and with a busy league and invitational schedule, the PV Invite is a welcomed change.

Friday afternoon race times mean no early morning bus rides and no SAT testing conflicts! Palos Verdes is on the coast, so no brutal inland heat either. Lastly, there are some great prizes to be won. Scoring:
