



Pat Hadley Memorial Invitational Information Packet 2025

The Pat Hadley Scholarships were established in memory of Patricia Hadley (1958-2013). Pat taught ceramics for 18 years at Valencia High School in Placentia, California and was also head coach for boys cross-country and distance coach for track and field. Under Coach Hadley's guidance, Valencia enjoyed more than a decade of preeminence in League, Section and State level competition. Mrs. Hadley was described in the student newspaper *El Tigre* as a teacher with wholehearted dedication to her students. "She was loved by countless students, athletes, coaches, and teachers."

While her competitive accolades are impressive, Coach Hadley's most powerful impact was in the lives of her students and athletes. She regularly donated her time, energy, and resources to all who needed her support. She provided countless shoes and snacks, drove alumni to college registration appointments, took suburban kids to nature (usually for their first time) and cultivated honesty, integrity, and determination in all she encountered.

Anyone who had the pleasure of working with Coach Hadley is better because of the experience. Her legacy lives on in the hundreds of successful alumni that are all proud to have been "her boys," as well as in today's Tiger Cross Country team as it carries the spirit of Pride, Tradition, and Excellence that Coach Hadley personified.

Bus Drop Off & Pick Up Location:

- **Bus drop off will be off Rolling Hills Drive and Associated Rd. (Please see map attached below)**
- After drop-off, buses will be directed to park at Valencia High School (500 N. Bradford Ave, Placentia, CA 92870) until pick up is requested.
- No buses will be allowed to park inside Craig Park, to allow for spectator parking.

Spectator Parking:

- Spectator parking is \$5.
- **Note: Parking inside the park, closest to the races, will be impacted. You are encouraged to arrive early, as parking inside the park will fill quickly. Please see the map attached below for reference.**

Team Cap at 22 schools:

- **This year we will be limiting the meet to the first 22 schools that register.**
- Please make payments online via [Athletic.net](https://athletic.net) or mail payment to Valencia HS (Att: Cross Country/Alicia Jacinto) at 500 N. Bradford Ave, Placentia, CA 92870. Checks payable to "Valencia HS Cross Country".
- Please email me if you are unable to mail the check ahead of time in order to secure your spot.

Cost:

- \$600 for full team (Boys and Girls)
- \$400 for all four grade levels (Boys or Girls)
- Or \$10 per individual if less than 10 runners (per gender)
- **Checks made payable to "Valencia HS Cross Country" and received by the entry deadline on Tuesday, September 2nd OR payment may be made online via Athletic.net.**

Registration:

- Through Athletic.net. Registration closes on Tuesday, September 2nd, 2025 at 10pm.
- Pick up Team packet by the Finish Line

Team Camp Sites:

- Teams may set up camp on the grass. Please **DO NOT** set up camp on the field where the finish line is set up or on the baseball fields.
- Trash bags have been included in the team packet.

Snack Shack:

- T-shirts! Get yours quickly before they sell out!
- Additional water, Gatorade, and prepackaged snacks will also be sold.
- B&C Burgers will be on site to provide breakfast burritos, burgers, etc.

Awards:

- Top 30 athletes in each race will receive a medal as they exit the finish chute

Athletic Trainer:

- We will have two trainers available
- One trainer will be stationed at the Finish Line with another mobile trainer throughout the race course.
- Please help us ensure that all athletes are safe by checking in with your athletes and making sure that they are all hydrated and nourished to race.
- Water station will be stationed at the Finish Line for athletes.

- 10:10am - Girls Junior Race - Top 30 medal
- 10:30am - Boys Junior Race - Top 30 medal

- High School Races: 3 Miles
- Alternate 3K course ready if there are any heat warnings in place.

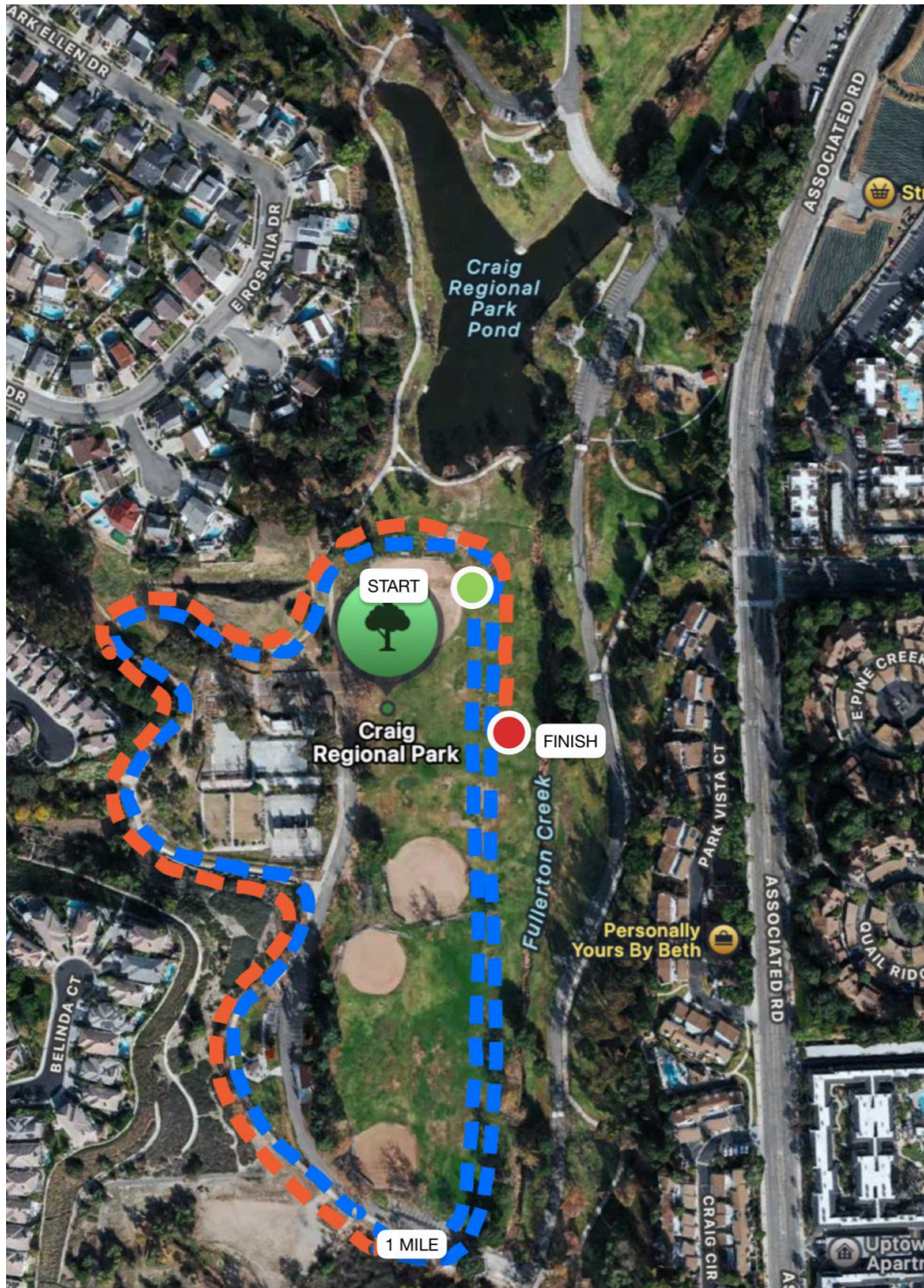
